SECTION 8. The Bred-by-Exhibitor Class shall be for dogs that are:

- Six months of age or older as of the first day of the show:
- Not Champions of record on the date of closing of entries for the show;
- Individually registered with The American Kennel Club as of the date of the show;
- Owned or co-owned by any of the breeders of record and an owner of record of this dog.

The person handling the dog in this class must be a breeder of record and an owner of record of this dog.

In any subsequent classes for which a dog from the Bred-by-Exhibitor Class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle.

Best Bred-by-Exhibitor Award - Offered at the National Specialty. \$50 Cash Award for Best Bred-By-Exhibitor meeting one of the following requirements. If the winning PBGV is 30 months of age or older, his/her CHIC number must be included on the entry form and the Dam's CHIC number must be included on the entry form by her name. If the winning PBGV is less than 30 months of age, only the Dam's CHIC number must be included on the entry form by her name. *When making an online entry, please enter the CHIC number(s) and for which dog in the comment section. This cash award is offered by Anne Gallant in recognition of our many fine breeders.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Single Dog Entries Eligible for BOB Competition

JUDGE'S AWARD OF MERIT

At the conclusion of Best of Breed judging, after picking Best of Breed, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, and Select Dog & Select Bitch, the judge at his discretion may choose up to 10% of the Best of Breed entry for an Award of Merit. The award shall be a green and gold rosette.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

Non-Regular (Additional) Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

- Stud Dog Class Will be for Stud Dogs and two of their get. Stud dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. Get only to be judged, based on the merits of the Get. Although the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the stud dog must be examined to determine if it has any condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for the breed. Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition, or some other Non-Regular Class.
- Brood Bitch Class Will be for Brood Bitches and two of their Produce. Brood Bitches must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Produce. Owner of Brood Bitch need not necessarily be owner of the Produce. Produce only to be judged, based on the merits of the Produce. Although the merits of the Brood Bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the brood bitch must be examined to determine if it has any condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for the breed. Produce must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition, or some other Non-Regular Class.
- Brace Class The two dogs with identical ownership comprising a brace must be named at the time of the entry, only a single entry fee for the brace class is required. If a dog which is to be part of a brace is not entered in a single-class entry, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only" for a fee of \$35.00. In making entries for "Brace Class Only" full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for each dog entered in another class and entered as part of a brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes as "Brace Class". If more than one brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH brace must be designated, Brace No. 1, Brace No. 2, etc.
- Pack Class (National Specialty Only) The pack consists of an entry of at least 6 dogs that are all bred, co-bred, owned or co-owned by the exhibitor. The entry is made in the name of the kennel represented by the dogs as well as the exhibitor's name(s). The dogs are brought into the ring by up to 2 handlers, one of which must be the named exhibitor. The dogs will be judged on a point system with 120 being the maximum. half the points (60) are allotted for how well the pack corresponds to breed type, and the other half (60) are allotted on size (30) and color (30) of the whole. The dogs are judged as a pack rather than as individuals; they are judged on type, size and color as a whole, they are not gaited. All dogs judged in the pack class must be entered in the regular classes. The judges shall choose one winner. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a pack must be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes. "Pack Class". If more than one pack is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each pack must be designated "Pack No. 1, Pack No. 2", etc. Entry fee is \$35.00 per pack.
- Three Generation Pedigree Class (National Specialty Only) Each entry will consist of 3 specified PBGVs, dogs and/or bitched from 3 different generations, eg. sire-daughter-grandson, in any combination as long as they are direct descendants. The 3 generations need not be consecutive. All 3 dogs must be bred, co-bred, owned or co-owned by the exhibitor. All three will be listed in the catalog. The entry is judged as a unit, with no one outstanding individual outweighing the quality of the others. All are judged on how well they represent the ideal of the breed standard, quality and consistency. The quality of each generation should meet or exceed that of the previous generation. The judge shall choose one winner. Entry fee is \$35.00 per unit.
- Team (National Specialty Only) The four dogs with identical ownership comprising a team must be named at the time of the entry, only a single entry fee for the team class is required. If a dog which is to be part of a team is not entered in a single-class entry, it must be entered for "Team Class Only" for a fee of \$35.00. In making entries for "Team Class Only" full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for each dog entered in another class and entered as part of a team must be maked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes as "Team Class". If more than one team is entered by the same owner, the dogs accomplanying EACH team must be designated, Team No. 1. Team No. 2, etc.

NOTE: As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Brace, Team, Pack or Three Generations Pedigree Classes is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged First in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

The Canine Athlete - Dr. Judith M. Shoemaker, DVM

Dr. Showmaker takes a holistic approach, seeking to create an awareness and understanding of balance as the key factor in improving quality of life.

A graduate of the University of Georgia College of Veterinary Medicine, Dr. Shoemaker conducts a complementary medicine mixed practice with a focus on sports medicine, acupuncture, chiropractic, farriery, dentistry and other adjunctive therapies for difficult conditions. Her patients include top-level competitors in many disciplines and wonderful companions as well.

Friday, May 9, 2014

Eye Exams - Dr. Andras Komaromy, DrMedVet, PhD, DACVO, DECVO

Ophthalmic exams by Dr. Andras Komaromy. Dr. Komaromy will once again be offering eye examinations for PBGVs. The evaluation will include indirect ophthalmoscopy and slit lamp blomicroscopy plus gonioscopy and tonometry. Not only will the examination provide evaluation of your dog, but information from the examination and a blood sample collected will aid in the on-going research of primary open-angle glaucoma (POAG) being conducted in his labratory at Michigan State University. Since dilation of the eyes is essential, appointments are best scheduled after your ring time. Appointments will start about 11:00 A.M. Fee \$35.00

Dr. Komaromy is board certified by both the American and European College of Veterinary Ophthalmologists. He is a member of the ACVO Genetics Committee and served as chair from 2004 to 2009. The Komaromy Lab at MSU studies achromatopsia (also called rod monochromacy or total congenital color blindness), an inherited retinal disease that primarily affects cone photoreceptors. The Lab is also investigating POAG, a disease that affects the inner retina and optic nerve. It is one of the leading causes for blindness, but the precise disease mechanisms are poorly understood. The Lab has developed a valuable model to futher investigate the disease mechanisms in POAG, and is developing new therapeutic strategies.

Cardio Exams - Dr. Luis Braz-Rulvo DVM, DVSc, DACVIM (Cardiology)

Dr. Luis Braz-Ruivo will offer either cardiac auscultation or echocardiographic examination. The cost will be \$160.00 for the echo or \$40.00 for auscultation alone. Since the procedure is non-invasie and non-traumatic, appointments may be scheduled at any time, either pre-or-post your ring time. Although not currently required for a CHIC number, a cardiac evaluation may well be a good idea. As of December 2012, OFA ranked the PBGV as fourteenth of 121 breeds with the potential for cardiac problems.

A native of Brazil, where he graduated from the University of Lisbon, Dr. Braz-Ruivo is a board certified veterinary cardiologist. He enjoys all aspects of veterinary cardiology in small animals, but he has a particular interest in the treatment of congestive heart failure, diagnosis of congenital heart disease in breeding dogs and interventional cardiology.

Blood Draw

In addition to the blood draw to aid Dr. Komaromy's research, the PBGVCA and the PBGV Health & Rescue Foundationn will also sponsor a free blood draw for the CHIC DNA Repository. Participants will be required to complete the DNA Repository Application form and genetic health survey at the time of collection.

Microchip

Microchips will be available for \$10 including implantation. These are ISO chips that would be readable worldwide. Please note, however, the fee does not include the clost of registration with organizations such as AKC ReUnite.
