- Be a member in good standing with the PBGVCA for at least five years.
- Be an AKC Breeder of Merit
- Participate in PBGVCA activities when possible. Attend PBGVCA events and serve or consult in a PBGVCA committee or event.
- Be a recognized PBGV breeder with at least five titled PBGV.
- Be willing to offer breed expertise and assistance to breeders (experienced and novice) when called upon.
- Be articulate in describing the PBGVCA approved Breed Standard. Have knowledge of PBGV anatomy, temperament, form and function.
- Be willing to share knowledge of the PBGV in positive terminology, with integrity and without prejudice.
- Have regularly attended PBGVCA National Specialties and events.
- Have attended at least one (in person or on-line) PBGVCA sponsored Educational Workshops or Seminars in the last five years.
